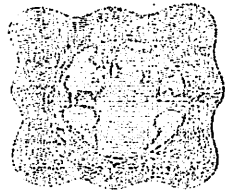
Examples

Newspaper		Newspaper and newspaper inserts
Magazines, Books, Paper		Magazines, phone books, office paper shredded paper, junk mail, envelopes, etc.
Corrugated Cardboard Paperboard		Cardboard only
Aluminum		Aluminum beverage & food cans <i>Must be empty and rinsed clean.</i>
Glass		Clear, brown & green glass (beer & wine bottles), all sizes of glass food containers. <i>Must be empty and rinsed clean.</i>
Plastic Bottles & Jugs		We accept all recyclable plastic containers - (no lids or caps) Separate #2 from all others. <i>Must be empty and rinsed clean.</i> NO STYROFOAM
Tin & Steel Products		Soup, coffee, fruit, & vegetable cans. <i>Must be empty and rinsed clean.</i>
Used Motor Oil & Batteries		Automotive oil, transmission fluid (Maximum of 60 weight) Rechargeable, button, lithium ion, car
Other items		Laser Jet, Ink Jet & Toner Cartridges <i>Must be in sealed container/bag.</i>

Recycling Rules

- ◆ All containers must be rinsed and clean. (especially milk jugs)
- ◆ Remove caps and lids from all glass and plastic containers.
- ◆ Yard waste (leaves, limbs) is accepted. Ask attendant where to dump.
- ◆ No butter tubs, yogurt containers accepted.
- ◆ No garbage or trash.
- ◆ No dirty rags or oil/gas soiled cloths.

Attendant on duty to ensure materials are properly sorted.
