# Office Paper

Printer paper, lined paper, envelopes, shredded paper.



Newspaper and ads, magazines, paperback books, white packing paper, junk mail.



Cans and lids, please rinse clean Labels are ok.

### **Aluminum**

Cans and lids, please rinse clean Labels are ok.



Hard cover, three ring binders, spiral notebooks (wire and plastic).

#### Cardboard

Clean corrugated boxes (staples and tape are ok) cereal and food boxes, brown paper bags.

# Plastics

Most soda and water bottles are #1. Remove lids, rinse clean. Labels are ok.



Milk jugs, laundry detergent bottles, etc. Remove lids, rinse clean. *Labels are ok.* 





Mostly food packaging. Remove lids, make sure to rinse clean! *Labels are ok.* 

## Clear Glass

Clear glass bottles and jars. Remove lids and rinse clean. *Labels and rings from lids are ok.* 

### Colored Glass

Bottles and jars only, remove lids and rinse clean. *Labels and rings from lids are ok.*

# **Plastic Bags or Styrofoam**

No plastic bags, bubble wrap, or other thin, filmy plastic. No styrofoam food containers, foam cups or egg cartons.

#### **Food Residue**

No pizza boxes or waxed cardboard, plastic, glass, or metal containers with food residue. No paper cups, plates, towels, or napkins.

# **Special Waste**

No electronics, batteries, household hazardous waste, light bulbs, applicances, tires, yard waste. Check with the Grant County Recycling Center for options.

# **Tanglers**

No hoses, cords or chains.
