Marion Utilities Stats:

- 180 miles of underground water pipes
- 3 overhead storage tanks
- 2 booster pump stations
- 1,700 freshly-painted hydrants
- More than 700 valves tested annually
- 4-6 million gallons of wastewater treated per day
- 45 miles of sanitary sewers
- 133 miles of combined sewers
