2019 SOLID WASTE RATES



This schedule of rates and charges applies to **Marion Utilities customers**, and supersedes previous schedules issued.

MONTHLY SERVICE CHARGE

The fee includes collection of up to two containers per week for each residence and one large item per month picked up by the Solid Waste Utility.

CUSTOMER DEPOSITS

See Ordinance. May be waived with positive credit check result.

CHARGES FOR PICK-UP OF LARGE ITEMS

See Ordinance. Residents are allowed one large item free of charge per month. If residents require more than one large item in a month, fees apply. See Website for cost associated with additional item collection, Transfer Station fees, Mega-Bag and Roll-Off Container fees.

*Roll-off Box 40 C.Y. (up to 8 tons)	\$730

*If you need a Roll-off Boxes, the following applies: Box delivery, pick-up, and disposal is \$250.00. There is an extra \$10/day fee for any box needed for more than 10 days.

CHARGES FOR EXTRA LARGE ITEM AT TRANSFER STATION

Residents may bring multiple items to our transfer station for an extra fee. Please visit our Solid Waste Office in the Administration Building at 1540 N. Washington St. prior to entering our Transfer Station.

Bag of Trash/ Miscellaneous Items	\$3 each
Truck Load (Level/MSW)	\$25
*Truck Load (Level/C&D)	\$30
Truck Load (Mounded/MSW)	\$37.50
*Truck Load (Mounded/C&D)	\$45
Misc. Solid Waste per Cubit Yard	\$10
*Construction/Demolition Solid Waste per Cubit Yard	\$12

*Shingles will be charged at the C&D rate x 1.5

PENALTY FOR DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS

A penalty for delinquent payments will be assessed on all accounts remaining unpaid 17 days from the mailing date of the bill. The penalty shall constitute 10% of the first \$3.00 and 3% of the remaining outstanding balance.
