Is that Recyclable?

A quick guide to recycling at Marion Utilities Recycling Center

Open **Mondays & Thursdays, 11am - 6pm**. • Located at **1300 N. Washington St.** Please have your items pre-sorted - An attendant will be on hand to see that recyclables are properly sorted.

YES! Drop off at MU Recycling Center – Here are the sorting categories we use.



Shredded Paper

All shredded paper.



Mixed Paper

Printer paper, lined paper, envelopes, newspaper and ads, magazines, paperback books, white packing paper, junk mail.



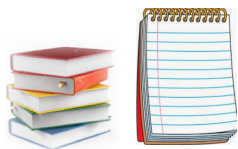
Steel

Cans and lids, please rinse clean
Labels are ok.



Aluminum

Cans and lids, please rinse clean
Labels are ok.



Books

Hard cover, three ring binders, spiral notebooks (wire and plastic).



Cardboard

Clean corrugated boxes (*staples and tape are ok*) cereal and food boxes, brown paper bags.



Plastics

Most soda and water bottles are #1. Remove lids, rinse clean. *Labels are ok.*



Plastics

Milk jugs, laundry detergent bottles, etc. Remove lids, rinse clean. *Labels are ok.*



Plastics

Mostly food packaging. Remove lids, make sure to rinse clean! *Labels are ok.* We will accept other plastics as the market allows, please check our website for updates.



Clear & Colored Glass

Glass bottles and jars. Remove lids and rinse clean. *Labels and rings from lids are ok.*



NO. Unfortunately, we don't accept these items for recycling at this time.

Plastic Bags or Styrofoam

No plastic bags, bubble wrap, or other thin, filmy plastic. No styrofoam food containers, foam cups or egg cartons.



Food Residue

No pizza boxes or waxed cardboard, plastic, glass, or metal containers with food residue. No paper cups, plates, towels, or napkins.



Special Waste

No electronics, batteries, household hazardous waste, light bulbs, appliances, tires, yard waste. Check with the Grant County Recycling Center for options.

Tanglers

No hoses, cords or chains.



If in doubt, throw it out! It's not worth jeopardizing a whole load of recyclables.
